Highlights



Our children were evaluated for a variety of educational support services, including speech therapy. Early intervention services can change a child's developmental path and improve outcomes for children, families, and communities

A trip to the pet store resulted in adopting a class pet - Finnley the beta fish! Caring for Finnley taught our children responsibility, care and compassion.



We participated in seven field trips this year, exposing our children and their families to new experiences. Highlights include visiting with the Apex FD and exploring the ladder truck, strawberry & pumpkin picking, and a fun day at Pullen Park.



We introduced cooking with foods like pancakes, pizza, and apple pie rolls! This helps foster a sense of independence and self-confidence in our children.



Our kids continued to develop physical, social, mental and emotional skills through consistent outdoor play. This year, we upgraded our playground with a playhouse and a larger sandbox to inspire imaginative play.

We added a dress-up center to the classroom, which nurtures imagination, sharpens motor skills, fosters emotional development, builds language skills and develops critical thinking.



Carolina Swims Foundation provided swim lessons to our children! Learning to swim helps children build physical strength, confidence in their problem-solving ability, and critical life-saving knowledge of water safety.
